



Set in 2,100 acres of parkland landscaped by Capability Brown, the Palace is surrounded by sweeping lawns and stunning formal gardens. The State Rooms are graced with priceless portraits, exquisite porcelain and magnificent tapestries.


Blenheim Palace is also famed as the birthplace of Sir Winston Churchill. Visit the suite of rooms where Sir Winston was born on 30th November 1874 and gain a fascinating insight into the life of our most beloved leader.


Your ticket will give you full access to all of the areas of the Fair, as well as access to all of the Blenheim Palace Grounds and Gardens.

By Train

Trains to Oxford run regularly from London Paddington and Birmingham New Street. Trains to Bicester run from London Marylebone and Birmingham Moor Street. (Call 08457 48 49 50 for more information.)

By Bus

The S3 bus to Woodstock runs from Oxford Train Station and Gloucester Green Coach Station at 30-minute intervals and stops at the Palace gate. It is a 10-minute walk to the palace from the gates.

Services run directly to Oxford from London and Birmingham throughout the day.
